An authorised dealer, before s/he applies to register a new “**Completed**” vehicle, birth-certed as “**Incomplete**” (e.g. Body Type 95 Chassis Cab), must firstly fill out this document and ensure that they are in possession of all Type-Approval documentation for the vehicle.

Completed forms should be submitted to Revenue via [myaccount](#) or ROS /My Enquiries / (My Query Relates to: **VRT / More Specifically: Vehicles New Irish Distributed**).

This Form must be accompanied by the COC of the “Incomplete” vehicle AND the COC of the “Completed” vehicle.

Upon receipt of the new Statistical Code, an authorised dealer can register the vehicle on-line through the Revenue Online Service.

Dealers are reminded that under S.I. 35 of the Road Traffic (Control of Supply of Vehicles) Regulations, 1991, it is an offence to supply, or offer to supply, a motor vehicle, which does not comply with Irish Road Traffic Regulations on the construction, equipment and lighting of vehicles.

The Revenue Commissioners collect taxes and duties and implement customs controls. Revenue requires customers to provide certain personal data for these purposes and certain other statutory functions as assigned by the Oireachtas. Your personal data may be exchanged with other Government Departments and agencies in certain circumstances where this is provided for by law.
