How to apply for a new Amusement Machine Permit and Amusement Machine Licence(s)

Amusement Machine Permit

Requirements:

A valid **Tax Clearance Certificate** is required where the applicant is an individual. Corporate applications will require a valid Tax Clearance Certificate for the company. Certificates do not need to be submitted. Revenue automated systems will verify that current Tax Clearance Certificates are in place.

Required Documents to accompany this Form:

Schedule of Public Places (page 3 of this form).

How to apply for an Amusement Machine Permit:

1. Complete the Application Form and submit to the National Excise Licence Office, Government Offices, The Glen, Waterford
2. The completed Application Form is processed and if approved an Application Notice will issue
3. On receipt of your Application Notice, you can then apply for your Amusement Machine Permit using the **Payment Options** below.

Amusement Machine Licence(s)

Requirements:

You must hold a valid Tax Clearance Certificate. However, **do not** submit the Certificate with your Application.

Required Documents:

A current valid Amusement Machine Permit (see above).

How to apply for an Amusement Machine Licence(s):

1. Complete the Application Form and submit to the National Excise Licence Office, Government Offices, The Glen, Waterford
2. The completed Application Form is processed and if approved an Application Notice will issue
3. On receipt of your Application Notice, you can apply for your Amusement Machine Licence(s) using the **Payment Options** below.

Payment Options
