#### How to apply for a new Amusement Machine Permit and Amusement Machine Licence(s)

#### **Amusement Machine Permit**

#### **Requirements:**

A valid **Tax Clearance Certificate** is required where the applicant is an individual. Corporate applications will require a valid Tax Clearance Certificate for the company. Certificates do not need to be submitted. Revenue automated systems will verify that current Tax Clearance Certificates are in place.

#### **Required Documents to accompany this Form:**

Schedule of Public Places (page 3 of this form).

#### How to apply for an Amusement Machine Permit:

- 1. Complete the Application Form and submit to the National Excise Licence Office, Office of the Revenue Commissioners, Anne Street, Wexford, Y35 E29K
- 2. The completed Application Form is processed and if approved an Application Notice will issue
- 3. On receipt of your Application Notice, you can then apply for your Amusement Machine Permit using the **Payment Options** below.
