Documentation Required

1. Bookmaker's Licence
2. Certificate of Suitability of Premises

Bookmaker's Licence

Applicants who require to register or renew the Registration of any Premises of which they are the Proprietor must hold a Bookmaker's Licence. The Licence does not have to be submitted with the application.

Certificate of Suitability of Premises

Applicants who require to register or renew the Registration of any Premises of which they are the Proprietor should apply to the Superintendent of An Garda Síochána for the District in which such premises are situated for a Certificate of Suitability of Premises that such premises are suitable for Registration in the Register of Bookmaking Offices.

A Licensed Bookmaker to whom a Certificate of Suitability of Premises has been given in respect of any premises of which they are the Proprietor should, within 21 days after the issue of such Certificate, apply to the Revenue Commissioners to Register or Renew the Registration of the Premises mentioned in such Certificate.

Application Process:

1. The Certificate of Suitability of Premises and completed application form should be submitted by email to the **National Excise Licence Office**. Please register for **MyEnquiries** on www.revenue.ie
2. When the application is processed, applicants will receive an Application Notice from the **National Excise Licence Office** to complete the application process on-line using the Revenue On-line Service (**ROS**). For details visit the Revenue website at www.revenue.ie or phone the ROS Helpline: 1890 201 106. Applicants will also be requested to indicate whether they are paying in full or availing of the instalment arrangement. If paying by instalment, the applicant will receive a notice from Revenue for payment of the second instalment approximately 3 weeks before this payment is due.
