Notes

Body Corporate

A body corporate is a group of persons which has had conferred on it by law a separate identity from the members comprising it. All companies established under the Companies Acts with or without limited liability, and those limited by share capital or by guarantee are included.

Relevant Officer

A Relevant Officer, in relation to a Body Corporate Licensee, means-

- (a) a person who exercises control (within the meaning of section 11 or 432 of the Taxes Consolidation Act 1997) in relation to the body, or
- (b) a member (including the Chairperson) of the body, or the Board or Board of Directors of the body, or any other person acting in such capacity, or
- (c) the Managing Director or Chief Executive Officer of the body, or any other person acting in such capacity.
