How to apply for a new Passenger Aircraft Licence(s)

Requirements:

The registration number of each Passenger Aircraft must be listed on this form.

The Application should be signed by the Licensee if a Sole Trader, by one of the Partners if a Partnership or, in the case of an Incorporated Firm by the Company Secretary or a Director of the Company. If this Application is approved the Revenue Commissioners will issue you with an Application Notice to apply for the Licence, on which you will be required to declare that you hold in your possession the following documentation:

- A valid Tax Clearance Certificate is required where the applicant is an individual. Corporate applications
 will require valid Tax Clearance Certificates for the company and each relevant officer. Certificates do not
 need to be submitted. Revenue automated systems will verify that current Tax Clearance Certificates are
 in place.
- If the Applicant is a Limited Company, a Duplicate Certificate of Incorporation dated not earlier than 4
 weeks before the date of application, will be required to take up the Licence. Duplicate Certificates of
 Incorporation are available at: www.cro.ie, LoCall 0818 452 000 or 01 804 5200.
- 3. If the Applicant trades using a name which is not that of the beneficial owner of the business, a Certificate of Registration of Business Name will be required to take up the Licence. Duplicate Certificates of Registration of the Business Name can be obtained at: www.cro.ie, LoCall 0818 452 000 or 01 804 5200.

How to apply for a Passenger Aircraft Licence(s):

- 1. Complete the Application Form and submit to the National Excise Licence Office, Office of the Revenue Commissioners, Anne Street, Wexford, Y35 E29K. **Do not submit Payment with this Application.**
- 2. The completed Application Form is processed and if approved an Application Notice will issue.
- 3. On receipt of your Application Notice, you can apply for your Passenger Aircraft Licence(s) using the **Payment Options** below.
