Candidates must, on or before 09 January 2026:

a.ii. Hold a qualification as an accountant, tax professional, solicitor or barrister (i.e., membership or entitlement to membership of a recognised professional body in these areas)

AND

b. Have a minimum of 3 years' relevant experience in a large professional firm, business, or Public Sector organisation.
