A minimum of 2 years' relevant transfer pricing technical and practical experience in a large professional firm, a large corporate business, or a Public Sector Organisation.

AND

A minimum of 2 years' relevant leadership and management experience in a large professional firm, a large corporate business, or Public Sector Organisation.
