Dear Sir/Madam,

We welcome any changes that will make the reporting of PAYE more efficient.

However, we would have concerns, in particular in a company which run two separate payrolls –

- One for senior staff and one for less senior staff.
- Different staff members are responsible for each payroll and neither have access to each other records.

If you give permission under PAYE ROS access for the filing of payroll records then both records for both senior and other staff can be viewed. This is a breach of confidentiality and will lead to major issues.

We would like this issue to be addressed i.e. multiple users have access to ROS without each knowing what details are submitted relating to employees i.e. in the above scenario the staff member filing the less senior staff payroll would not be able to view the payroll records of senior staff.
