

Welcome to our special edition Statistics Bulletin for June 2020.

Revenue's 2019 Annual Report is now published and, as is customary in recent years, we have also published a series of research reports on important topics related to our administration of the tax system.

These reports cover a wide range of topics, from in-depth analysis of the latest data on particular taxheads (Corporation Tax and VAT) to reviews of Revenue strategy and programmes to tackle tobacco and oil fraud.

Much of Revenue's focus in 2019 was on the successful introduction and implementation of "PAYE Modernisation", employers now report their employees' pay and statutory deductions in real-time to Revenue each time they operate payroll. We have prepared a report summarising the first twelve months' data collected through real-time reporting, to provide statistics and insights on incomes, tax paid and related topics. At the time of Budget 2019 (October 2018), PAYE Modernisation was predicted to yield an additional €50 million to the Exchequer in 2019. We have prepared a report that evaluates this prediction.

We also published a report on a national survey of employers conducted for the first time in 2019. Revenue anticipated a reduction in employer compliance costs and an increase in transparency for employees following the introduction of PAYE Modernisation. The results from the survey bear this out, with 89% of employers agreeing the reform has made payroll tax administration easier and 90% agreeing that transparency has increased

Real-time payroll reporting is the foundation on which the COVID-19 Temporary Wage Subsidy Scheme (TWSS) operates. Revenue has published weekly statistical reports covering all aspects of the operation of the TWSS since its inception. To supplement these, we have now published additional information on the PAYE system (including TWSS employees) for January to May 2020 inclusive. This additional information provides significant real-time insight into payroll, wage levels and emergency income supports for the first five months of the year. We also published for the first-time detailed statistics on the "warehousing arrangements" for COVID-19 related tax debt for businesses, which is operating since March 2020.
