Customs and Facilitating New Trading Relationship with Great Britain

Since 1 January 2021, a range of customs and other regulatory formalities apply to goods moving to, from or through Great Britain. We have assisted businesses adjust to the new trading environment, as well as continuing to support all third country traders.

Local Property Tax (LPT) Revaluation for 2022

The Finance (Local Property Tax) (Amendment) Act 2021 introduced a new structure for LPT from 2022 onwards. LPT for the years 2022 to 2025 will be based on property values on 1 November 2021. Revenue contacted over 1.4 million property owners (in respect of nearly 2 million properties) setting out the requirements for the next "valuation period" (2022-2025).
