eCustoms Notification 06/2022 outlines the sanctions measures relating to export to Russia as provided for in Council Regulation (EU) 2022/328.

The prohibitions outlined in the Regulation do not apply to the sale, supply, transfer or export of dualuse goods and technology or to the related provision of technical and financial assistance, for nonmilitary use and for a non-military end user, intended for:

- (a) humanitarian purposes, health emergencies, the urgent prevention or mitigation of an event likely to have a serious and significant impact on human health and safety or the environment or as a response to natural disasters
- (b) medical or pharmaceutical purposes
- (c) temporary export of items for use by news media
- (d) software updates
- (e) use as consumer communication devices

In order to avail of the exemptions listed above the declarant should enter the relevant code in Box 44.1 of the export SAD. The relevant codes are listed below:
