Revenue would like to remind traders that where a ‘Call to Customs’ channel (excluding a seal check) has issued for an unaccompanied trailer, the relevant PBN should not be checked into Customs unless the driver is present in the port and is available to transport the unit immediately to the designated terminal, following receipt of the text message to present for inspection.

It has come to the attention of the Government agencies in the RoRo ports that some PBNs for unaccompanied trailers are being checked in to Customs when the unit is not available for inspection as the driver is not present in the port. This practice can have a significant negative impact on other units waiting for and available for inspection.

Revenue would also like to take this opportunity to remind all traders involved in bringing goods into Ireland by truck or trailer on a RoRo ferry of their obligations to correctly follow the channel information at disembarkation for the associated PBN.

Revenue kindly request that this notice is adhered to.
