Trader Engagement

- 17,000 traders currently interact with Customs systems
- 83,901 traders identified as having traded with the UK in 2017.
- Segmentation of Trader Base
 - Logistic Companies
 - Large Economic Operators
 - Other Economic Operators
 - Software providers

Trader Engagement

- 13,429 businesses in total received letters
- Software provider engagement 29th November

- Customs Agents / brokers information seminar 9th January 2019

Trader Engagement

- Collaboration with other State Agencies
 - Enterprise Ireland
 - Department of Agriculture, Food and the Marine
 - HSE Environmental Health Service
 - Department of Business, Enterprise and Innovation

- UK as a 3rd country will mean customs declarations will be required
- Significant increase in the number of
 - import and export declarations
 - Transit declarations
 - S&S declarations
