1. Introduction

Centralised Clearance for Import (CCI) allows authorised economic operators (AEOs) to declare goods in one Member State (Supervising Member State). These goods can be physically imported in a different Member State (Presentation Member State). The economic operator communicates only with the supervising customs office as single point of contact. The digitalisation of the Centralised Clearance for Import concept streamlines communication between the different Customs Offices in different Member States.

The electronic systems facilitating CCI is scheduled for implementation in Ireland in 2025.

In advance of the implementation of CCI, the European Commission has launched a <u>survey</u> to collect information on the traders' preparation for using Centralised Clearance for Import System at EU level.

The survey is aimed at the European companies that wish to become authorised for the use of CCI.

The deadline for completion of the survey is 5 April 2024.
