## 1. Introduction

Georgia have become a Contracting Party to the Convention on Common Transit (CTC) Procedure and SAD Convention. With effect from 1<sup>st</sup> February 2025, Georgia has been using the electronic transit system – NCTS (New Computerised Transit System) for transit operations.

All traders who wish to include Georgia as an office of transit /destination in a transit movement, must amend their comprehensive guarantee to do so. Non-AEO traders must also amend their guarantor's undertaking to include Georgia and provide an address for service in Georgia.
