## 1. Introduction

The Carbon Border Adjustment Mechanism (CBAM) will go live on 1 January 2026. Details of this new initiative were published in previous <u>eCustoms Notification 24/2025</u>.

It is important for CBAM importers and their agents to note the following guidance when completing an import declaration in AIS for CBAM goods.

Please ensure that the Taric document code Y128 and the CBAM account number are declared at 'Goods Shipment Item level' as follows:

Data element 2/03 Documents produced, certificates and authorisation, additional references:

**Document type: Y128** 

Document identifier: CBAM account number

Revenue are aware of a missing validation rule that should prevent Y128 codes from being entered at 'Goods Shipment level' and we are working on a fix to issue shortly. In the meantime, declaring goods at 'Goods Shipment level' may result in the declaration not progressing in AIS and an MRN will not issue.
