

- Simplified express industry







WHAT WE KNOW NOW

Our Trader Engagement Programme indicates:

- Number of new traders could be potentially in the region of 92,000
- Most SMEs will need to engage a customs clearance agent
- Some larger Operators will complete declarations in house
- Some logistics companies will submit declarations on behalf of clients
- > The post-Brexit estimated figure will exceed 19 million




