



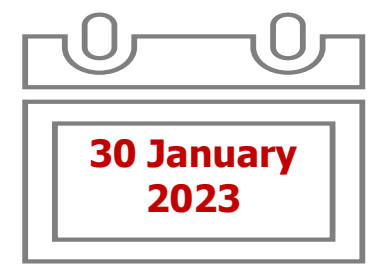

Declarants and any traders they represent should be preparing for their move to AES now

Engagement To Date

- Issued letters to 12,000 exporters, agents and carriers in April 2022
- One-to-One engagement with trade where required
- Four AES information sessions with trade – over 500 attendees
- Further AES information sessions will be delivered in December and January
- Updates on AES communicated directly to trade via the AES mailing list

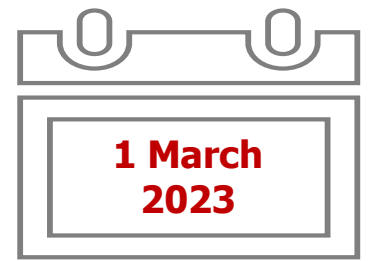

ICS2- Release 2



Freight forwarders should engage with their air carriers to establish who will complete the ICS2 filings.

Engagement To Date

- One to One engagement with Irish Air handlers
- Direct engagement with Express Carriers – meetings on a regular basis
- Communication with Freight Forwarders via the Irish Freight Forwarders Association
- Publication of EU documentation relating to ICS2 R2 circulated to air carriers
