

Israeli Settlements in the Occupied Palestinian Territory (Prohibition of Importation of Goods) Act 2026



Application for Exemption in relation to importation of goods from certain locations

For the purposes of section 6(1) of the Israeli Settlements in the Occupied Palestinian Territory (Prohibition of Importation of Goods) Act 2026 (No. 57 of 2026) (the Act of 2026), I confirm that I intend to import goods that originated in a postal code specified in Schedule 2 to an order made under section 3 of the Act of 2026.

Pursuant to section 6(1) of the Act of 2026, I apply for an exemption in relation to the importation of the goods concerned from the application of the Act of 2026.
