

Mobile Machinery

As advised by the Road Safety Authority, for the purposes of type approval, **Mobile Machines** are vehicles which are not considered a means of transport for either goods or passengers, and **are not based on a conventional truck chassis**.

Examples include:

- Road roller,
- back-hoe loader,
- digging machine,
- self-propelled mobile access platform (cherry picker - non vehicle mounted)
- road planer,
- road paver,
- large mobile cranes.

Where a vehicle, pertaining to be Mobile Machinery, is presented on a conventional truck chassis, **it is subject to EU Type Approval**.

In order to be registered, these vehicles must conform to the requirements of Directive 2007/46/EC and, **where presented as new**, must be accompanied by the appropriate EU Certificate of Conformity.

The NSAI should be contacted with regard to IVA or NSSTA approval where an EU Certificate of Conformity is not available from the original manufacturer.
