- If the transferees are married to each other or in a civil partnership
- If you have requested the filer of the Stamp Duty return to make the refund claim on your behalf.

Where one transferee is claiming the refund on behalf of both, this form must be completed by the other. The refund will be made to the account nominated by the person making the claim.
