

Self-assessment: Committees of wards of court

A Ward of Court is an individual who has been adjudged by the President of the High Court to lack the capacity, by reason of age or mental incapacity, to handle her/his own financial affairs. Wards are placed by the President of the High Court under the care of a "committee". Such committee, which may consist of one individual, has the responsibility for the day to day care of the ward subject to the approval of the Registrar of Wards of Court, an officer of the High Court.

The Committee of a Ward of Court, in that capacity, is a chargeable person for self-assessment purposes.
