New Excise Statistical Datasets

We are expanding our Excise publications. The first set of new detailed statistical datasets was published on Revenue.ie in March 2024. Other commodity-specific datasets will issue in the coming months.

The first new dataset is **Sugar Sweetened Drinks Tax (SSDT)**, recording bi-monthly liabilities and annual receipts by tax band. The second is **Vehicle Registration Tax (VRT)**, recording new and used registrations per quarter, broken down by Revenue Vehicle Category, VRT tax band and engine type.

Forthcoming Revenue Annual Report 2023 and Research Publications

Revenue's Annual Report for 2023 is scheduled for publication on 25 April 2024 and will be accompanied by additional research & statistical publications covering Corporation Tax, Income Tax, VAT and VRT.

New analysis this year will include a statistical breakdown of Customs declarations and research on employer deaths using real-time payroll data.

Excise Registers

The Excise Acts, and their associated regulations, require that Revenue publish a series of registers for Excise customers. These registers are updated monthly:

- Current Valid Licensed Auto Fuel Traders
 - Licensed Marked Fuel Traders
 - Register of Licensed Bookmakers
- Licensed Remote Bookmaking Operations
 - Register of Bookmaking Offices
 - Register of Renewed Liquor Licences
