From 20 August 2023, products originating in Ghana may, on importation into the EU, benefit from preferential tariff treatment provided by the EU-Ghana stepping-stone Economic Partnership Agreement (EPA). This benefit will be available upon submission of an origin declaration made out by:

- an exporter from Ghana registered in the Registered Exporter (REX) system of the European Union, or
- any exporter from Ghana, for any consignment consisting of one or more packages containing originating products, the total value of which does not exceed EUR 6 000.

It should be noted that, from 20 August 2023, the following documentation shall no longer be accepted to claim preferential treatment upon importation into the EU.

- movement certificates EUR.1 endorsed by Ghana customs authorities, or
- invoice declarations made out by approved exporters in Ghana.
