## Setting up a variable direct debit on ROS

- Login to ROS.
- On the My Services Screen scroll down to 'Payments & Refunds'.
- Click on 'Manage Bank Accounts'.



- Under 'Manage Direct Debits' check if you have an existing fixed direct debit in place for PAYE-Emp. If so, you should cancel this before setting up a variable direct debit.
- Select 'Variable Direct Debit' from the drop-down menu.
- Click on 'Manage Direct Debits'.





• Select 'Create New Mandate' to set up a new variable direct debit.

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Variable Direct Debit					
The Variable Direct Debit Scheme is for you if you wish to authorise (A) the Revenue Commissioners to send instructions to your bank to debit your account and (B) your bank to debit your account in accordance with the instruction from the Revenue Commissioners.
